- No special handling, can be sold as regular case goods in warehouse program, saves on ice, insulated boxes and expensive courier charges

WHEN TO APPLY* NEMA-GLOBE NEMATODES?

Nema-globe nematodes can be used any time the insect is in larval stage (i.e. in the soil). Typically temperatures need to be 50 °F - 90 °F for the nematodes to be able to enter into and kill a soil pest.

Grubs : Spring & Late Summer – early Fall Fungus Gnats : Indoors – all year round Flea &Tick : All year round in some regions

Ants: When adults are active, generally mid March to November

* Timing of application varies by geographic region.

HOW TO APPLY?



Hose end sprayer: You can use most common lawn and garden sprayers on the market. Simply add the bio-pouch containing the nematodes directly into the sprayer and add water to fill line.



Watering Can: For small areas you like a vegetable gardens you can apply with a watering can by dropping the bio-pouch into the sprayer, add water and mix well to release nematodes from the bio-pouch.
